

CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT PLAN

Beginning Women's Chorus

Grades: 9 - 12

RULES

1. Students will take responsibility for their actions.
2. Students will always be respectful.
3. Students will be prepared and ready to learn.
4. Students will not use inappropriate language. (cursing, lewdness, etc.)
5. Students will not bully any other student verbally or physically.
6. Students will not cheat or be dishonest.

CONSEQUENCES

Level 1: Student will receive a verbal warning.

Level 2: Student will be asked to sit at the front of the room next to the teacher/piano and write the rules and consequences to be graded as written assignment.

Level 3: Student will receive an after school detention with the teacher.

Level 4: Student will receive a referral and a parent will be notified.

Level 5: Student will be sent to the principal and consequences will continue at their discretion.

REWARDS

Group Rewards

- Good behavior will result in allowance of picking repertoire as a group.
- Proper participation and growth will result in more outside experiences and opportunities (field trips, gigs, etc.)

Individuals Rewards

- Students who show exemplary behavior will be considered for leadership roles within the classroom (ex. Row captains, section leaders, officers)
- Students with appropriate and proper behavior will receive excellent grades for participation.

PROCEDURES**Materials**

- Students must have a pencil, paper, chair, and be ready to stand for the pledge of allegiance/be on time for class.
- Students must have their cell phones (and all other electronics) silenced, in their bags and on the sides of the classroom by the start of class.
- If students are late to class without a pass or valid excuse, they will lose all of their materials points for the day because they have will have missed the grading process.
- Late students will be graded on their materials within 1 minute of their arrival with a valid pass.

Participation

- Choir is a team effort and is only successful if all members are actively participating. A large part of the students' grade will be based on their daily class participation.
- A student may earn a total of 10 participation points. A lack in participation will result in a loss of a participation point.
- Students must be singing when instructed and engaged in classroom questions and discussions.
- If a student is involved in a consequence, they will lose 5 points for reaching level 2, and all points for reaching level 3.

Rehearsal

- Students will sing to the best of their ability everyday.
- Rehearsal requires a high level of focus.
- In between singing students must listen and wait for the next instruction.
- If a student is lost, they should quietly ask their neighbor and keep going.
- Students should ask questions that are based on the current rehearsal topic. Personal questions should be saved for before or after class.

Room Set-Up

- Students will sit in their assigned chair and section.
- All extra chairs will be stacked before class begins.
- Students must have their cell phones (and all other electronics) silenced, in their bags and on the sides of the classroom by the start of class.
- The board in the front of the classroom posts the rules and consequences and each student will fill out a signed contract stating that they have read and understand all rules, consequences, and procedures.
